

Student Procedures

- **1.** You can register by **paper** or **online** depending upon age. If you are younger than 13—register by paper.
- 2. <u>PAPER:</u> Secure SAT student's application form entitled *SAT Paper Registration Guide* from your high school counselor.

If you are in a rural district without a high school, call your nearest high school and/or school counselor for application form.



3. Check your deadline dates in the SAT Registration Bulletin.


Oct 7, Nov 3, Dec 3

Registration must be made in advance for the following test dates.

Nov 5, Dec 3, Jan 21

- **4.** Testing must be completed by **January 31, 2017**. <u>Later testing dates</u> are not accepted for this competition.
- 5. Register to take the **SAT or SAT Essay Test**.
- **6.** Choose a **testing site** that is close to you.
- 7. The cost of the test is \$45 or \$57 paid directly to the College Board. Montana AGATE does not require a fee.

8. Put High School Code in # 2 if registering by paper. This will allow for a 2nd copy in case a report becomes lost. The AGATE code number is <u>0605</u>. Put the Code <u>0605</u> in 22A. This code number assures that the results are sent to MT AGATE. See example:



9. Item # 3: Female or Male, Item#4: Current Grade Level, Item #8:Grad Date. This information is needed for the *Interpretive Guide*.

If you test in the 7th or 8th grade, your scores are removed from your file at the end of the year that you tested. If you don't want your scores removed, you must let College Program know before June of the year you tested. 7th & 8th Grade Students

We invite you to participate in the **2016-2017 SAT Challenge** conducted by *Montana AGATE* (Association of Gifted and Talented Education). We are looking for academically able and highly motivated seventh and eighth grade students who wish to gain additional insight into their future educational opportunites.

- 1. Grade: You must be in the seventh or eighth grade during the 2016-2017 school year.
- 2. **Test Scores**: You should have scored at the <u>95th percentile</u> or better on the national norms in at least one of the following sections or subtests of standardized aptitude or achievement tests Total Math, Total Verbal, or Total Battery.
- 3. Alternatives: If standardized test scores are not available, consider GPA Lists (A average or 3.5 GPA), Honor Roll Lists, and/or National Junior Honor Society Membership.
 Assistance from G/T or Enrichment Program Coordinators, Middle School "Teams", Faculty, Counselors, and/or Special Program Coordinators may be helpful in determining eligibility.

A <u>Program ID Form</u> is required; a photo is not.

Student Benefits

- 1. You will have a **challenging experience** which will compare your abilities with those of other highly able seventh and eighth graders.
- 2. You will receive information needed to interpret your scores from SAT and an **Interpretive Guide** from Montana AGATE.

- 3. **Scholarship awards** will be presented. The award is to be used to advance your learning. With the new scoring, criteria will be determined based on results of middle school students.
